Contract & Health Guarantee

1. Health Guarantee:

Crossfield Doodles guarantees that at the time of delivery, the dog is in good health having been examined by our veterinarian and having received all standard age-appropriate vaccines. The buyer has THREE (3) days from the time of receipt of dog to have dog examined by a veterinarian. Any request to return the dog to the seller for a replacement must be made within this time period and may only be requested should the dog prove to be sick upon arrival as diagnosed in writing by a veterinarian. This guarantee will be terminated immediately if the dog is not examined within the allotted time of THREE (3) days. A warranty against all life-altering genetic diseases is provided for one year after the date of birth. Should a genetic disease be discovered during this time that will substantially shorten the life of, or substantially alter the quality of life of the dog, Crossfield Doodles will provide the buyer with a dog from another litter when it becomes available, upon return of the original dog.

Due to the varying kinds of food and environmental conditions with which puppies come in contact and the fact that all puppies have immune systems that take time to mature, the terms of this guarantee will not be honored unless they are given NuVet Plus®, as directed by the manufacturer, for the entire guarantee period. Failure to do so will render this guarantee null and void except where prohibited by law.

Based on parentage and breed characteristics Crossfield Doodles will make informed predictions as to the following, but can not guarantee them: hypoallergenicity, shedding, size/weight, or coat type when dog is fully grown.

This health guarantee and any following are only applicable to the original purchaser, and if the dog is sold or given away all warranties or guarantees are void.

2. Hips:

A warranty for Hip Dysplasia is provided for two years after the date of birth. This warranty will be terminated should the dog be allowed to

become overweight or if the developing joints be over stressed at any point during the warranty period. If any hip problems are noticed, have your vet submit your dog's x-ray to the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA) for their evaluation and send us a copy of the report. Should the dog be found to have Hip Dysplasia, within its first two years, the buyer must provide Crossfield Doodles with proof. We reserve the right to confirm the results before a replacement is provided. The dog must be owned by the original owner and must not have sired or whelped a litter in order for the hip warranty to remain in effect. The original dog must be returned prior to receiving the replacement puppy.

3. Maintenance:

The buyer agrees to maintain this dog in good health, provide routine preventative health care including, but not limited to, inoculation, treatment for internal and external parasites, and preventative medication. Veterinary records must be provided to breeder if requesting a replacement. If any of the above preventative care has not been provided, this health guarantee will be void. Under no circumstances shall Crossfield Doodles be liable to the buyer or to any third party for any consequential, incidental, or special damages resulting from or in manner related to the dog. Upon receipt of puppy all veterinary care and its associated costs are the sole and exclusive responsibility of the buyer.

4. Breeding Rights

Buyer understands that puppy is being sold as a pet only. Buyer acknowledges that there are no expressed breeding rights and for any changes to this agreement there must be written consent by both parties. Buyer acknowledges and agrees to provide written proof from veterinarian verifying spay/neuter by _____. In the event the buyer does not show proof within noted time allowed buyer will be subject to an additional fee of 7500.00.

5. Going home kit

- Small bag of the puppy food your pup is used to. (If you want to use another high-quality pup food, transition slowly, mixing both for a couple of weeks, finally discontinuing use of the food Crossfield sends you.)
- A sample package of NuVet Plus canine supplement

- Pedigree information (see below)
- Your puppy's current vaccination/worming/health record.
- Microchip implant with accompanying registration information.
- A toy(s) with which your puppy and littermates have played. These gifts will smell like your pup and littermates which can make the transition to a permanent home easier. PLEASE REPLACE THIS STUFFED TOY with a sturdy dog-chew toy within a couple of days of bringing your new puppy home.

5. Our return/re-home policy is as follows:

- In the event that the Purchaser needs to immediately re-home dog, Purchaser agrees to ship puppy to Breeder at Purchaser's expense.
- In the event that re-homing the dog is not an emergency situation, Purchaser agrees to keep the dog until the Breeder can find a new home for the dog. This is a much better situation for the dog, so that it only needs to make one transition.
- Upon re-homing the dog, Breeder agrees to refund any proceeds (minus any expenses that are incurred by Breeder for the dog during the re-home process ie: training, boarding, vet care, grooming etc..) from the re-home to the original Purchaser.

As the Breeder/Seller I certify that the dog/puppy is free from illness and defects and does not appear clinically ill. All information provided is true to the best of my knowledge and belief. This agreement is one of total integration. All details of the Buyer/Breeders responsibilities and understandings are written within this agreement. There are no oral modifications to this contract.

The Buyer and Breeder accept all conditions stipulated in the pages above.
